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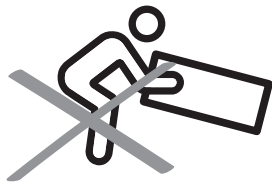
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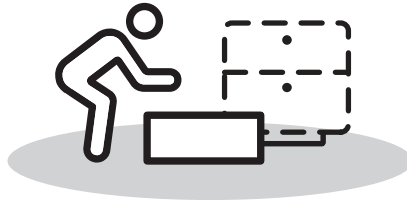
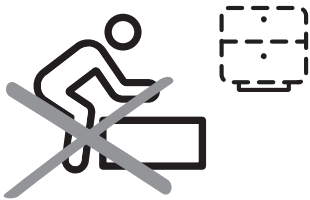
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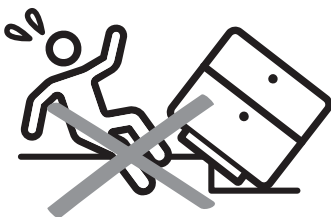
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Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.

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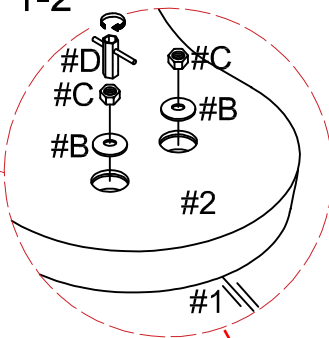


Attach rods (#A) to the glass top (#1).

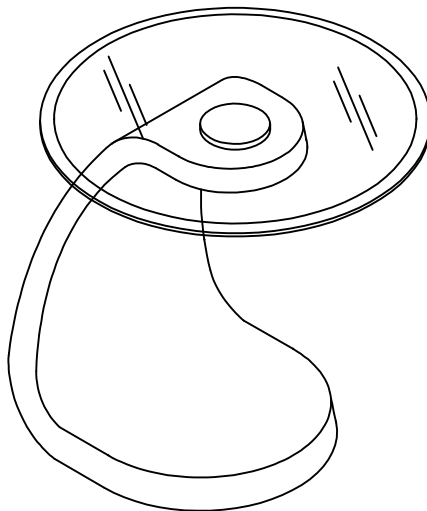
