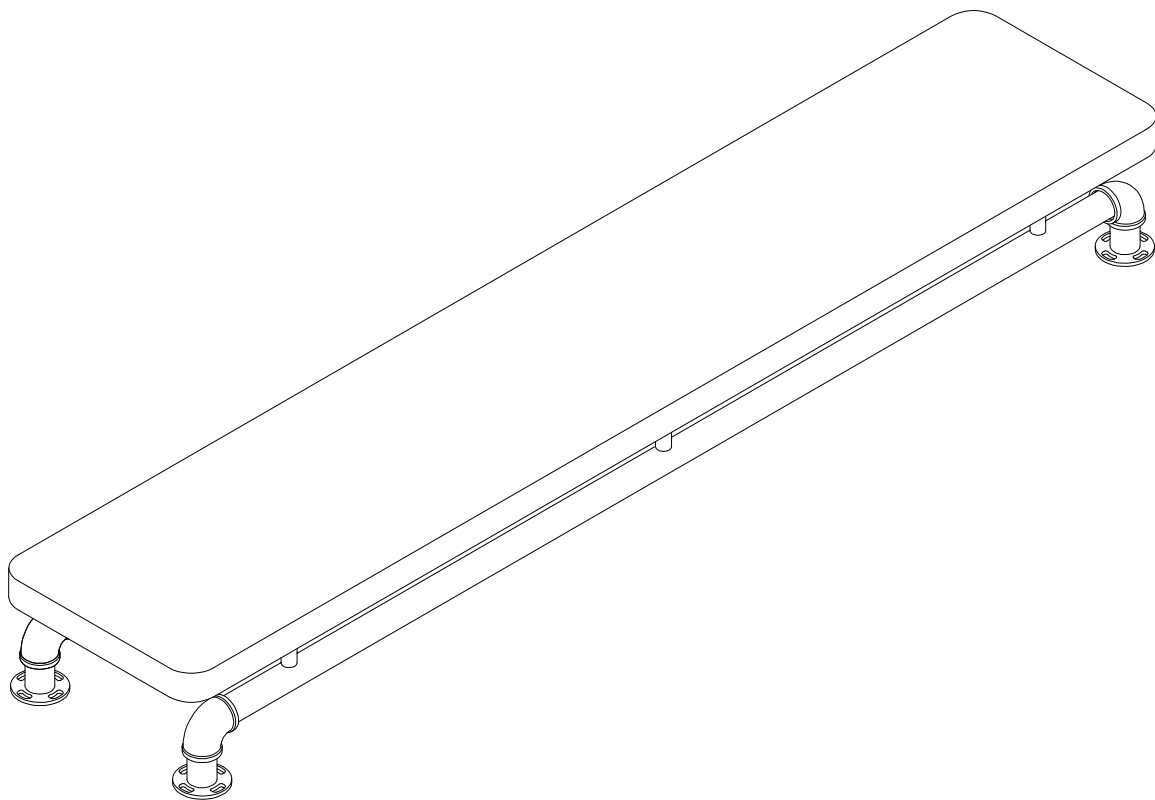


Assembly Instructions

1) Align the support frame (#2) to the holes on the top panel (#1), then insert bolt (#A) into each hole. Secure using the Allen wrench.



2) Align the connect tube (#3) to the holes on the support frame (#2), then insert bolts (#B) into each hole. Secure using Allen wrench.

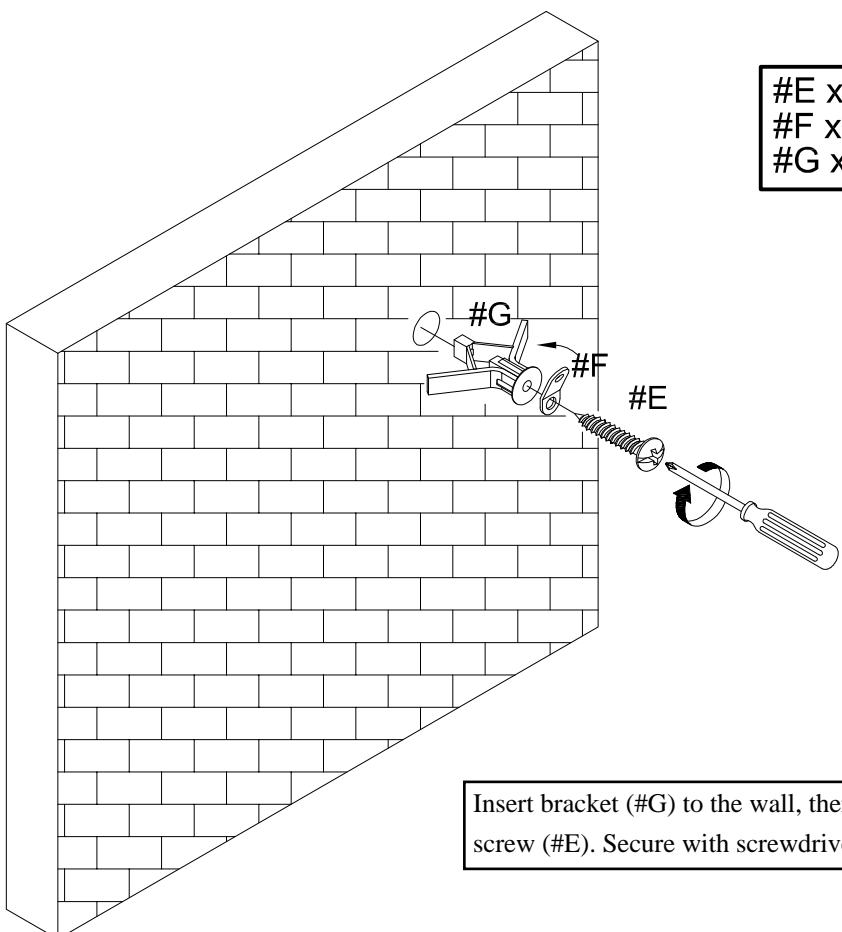

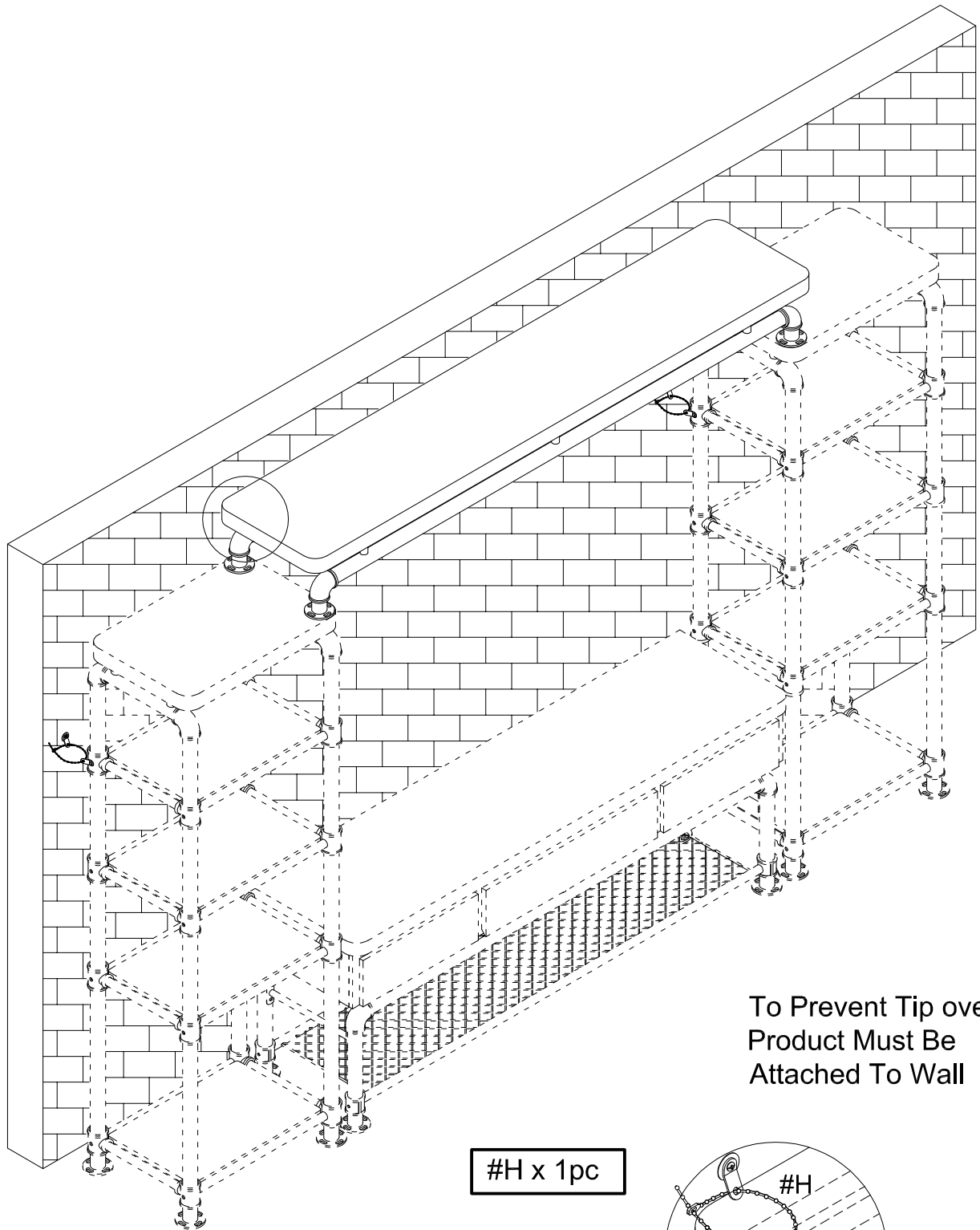
3) Insert the adjustable foot (#4) to support frame (#2), then place floor protector (#C) on it.

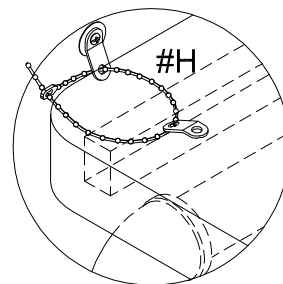


Insert bracket (#G) to the wall, then put metal plate (#F) onto screw (#E). Secure with screwdriver.

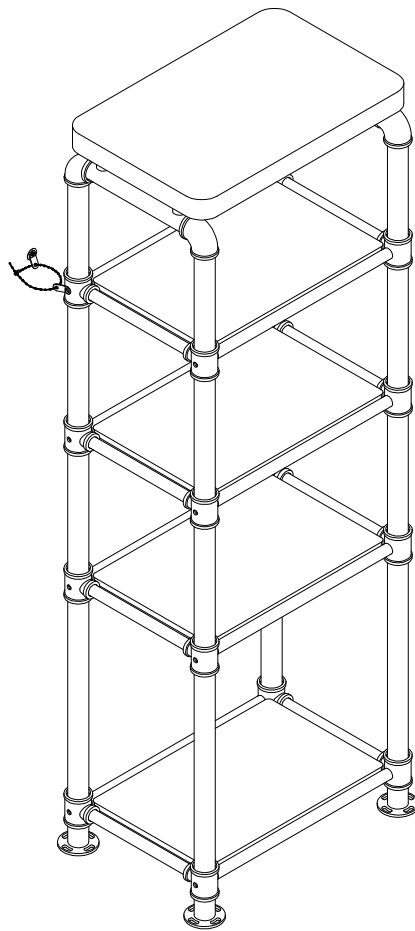

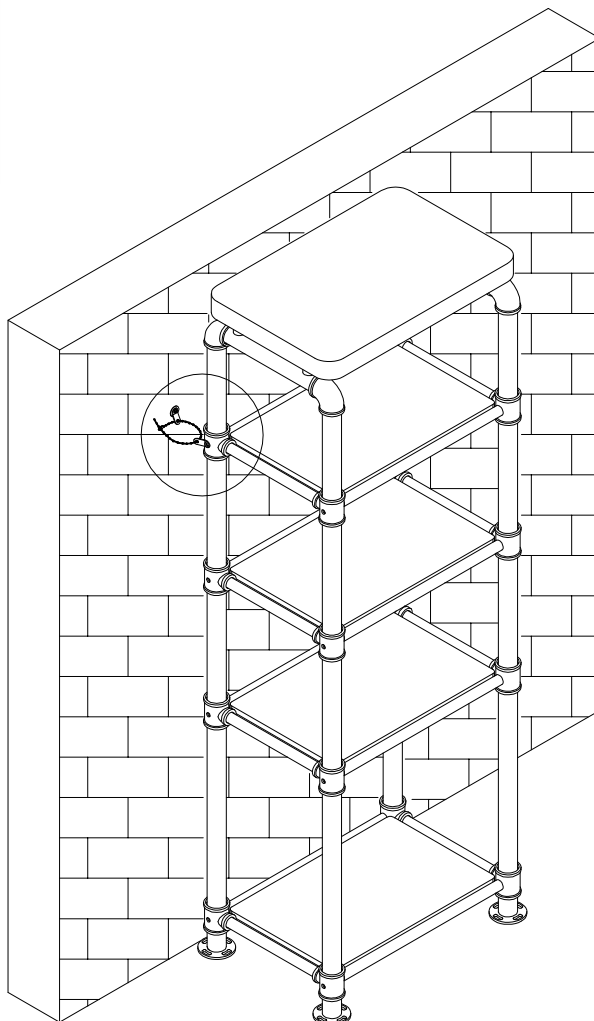
1. Align a washer (#B) to the

Insert a bolt (#A) and secure.





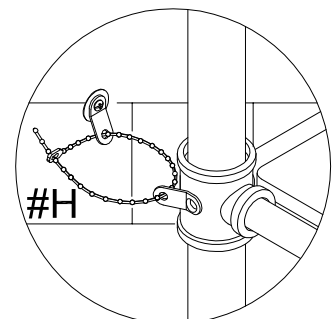

2. Align a bracket (#F) to the anchor, then insert a screw (#E). Secure using a screwdriver.

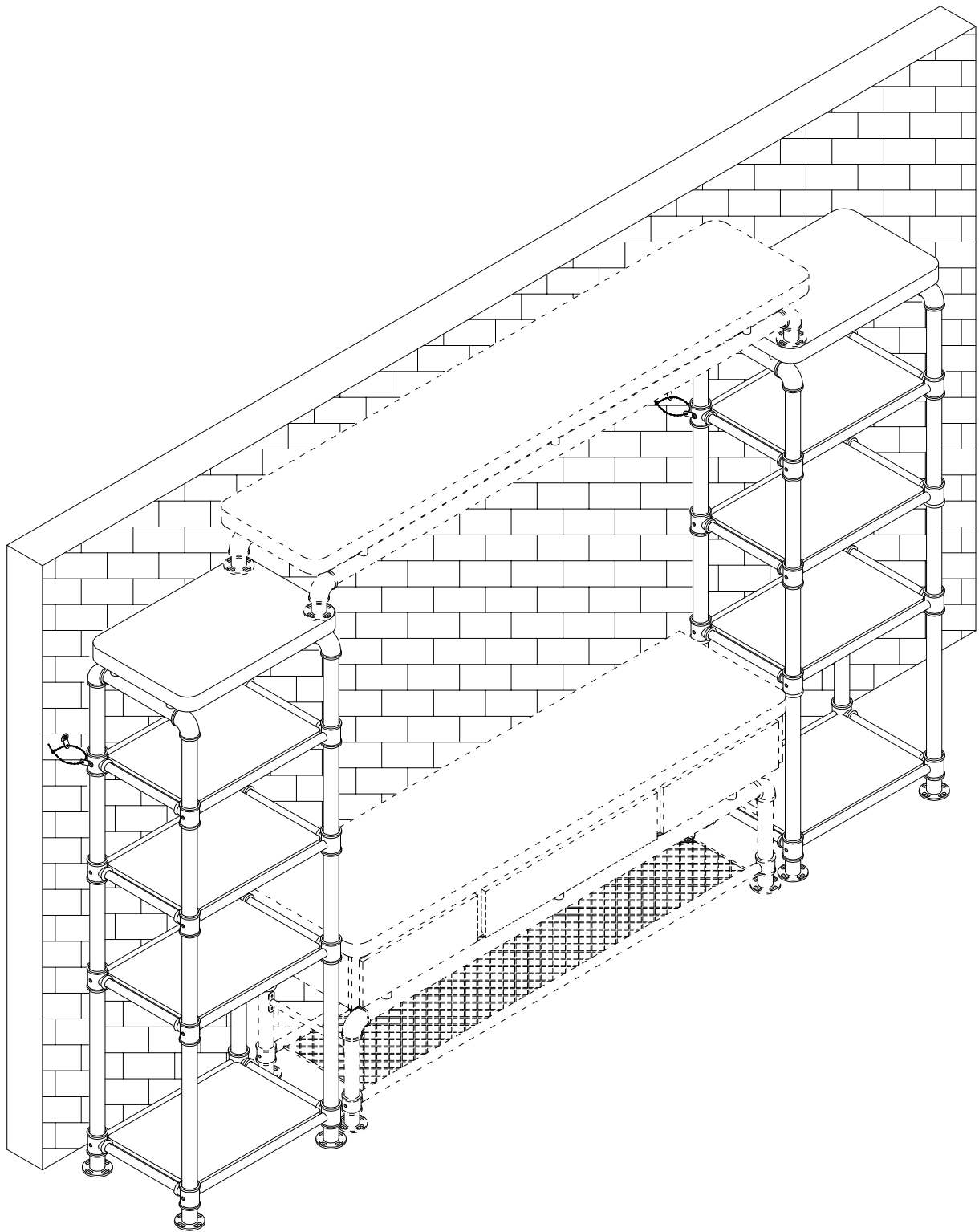

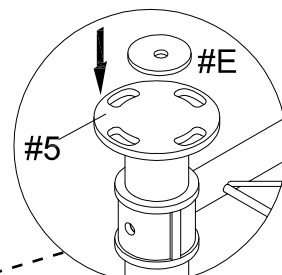
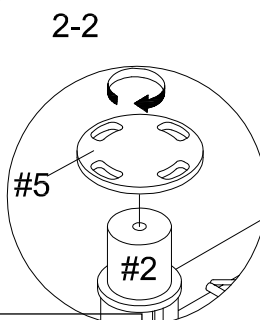
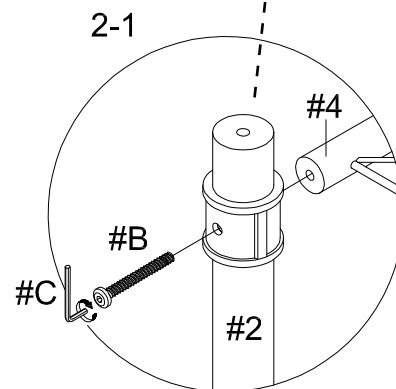
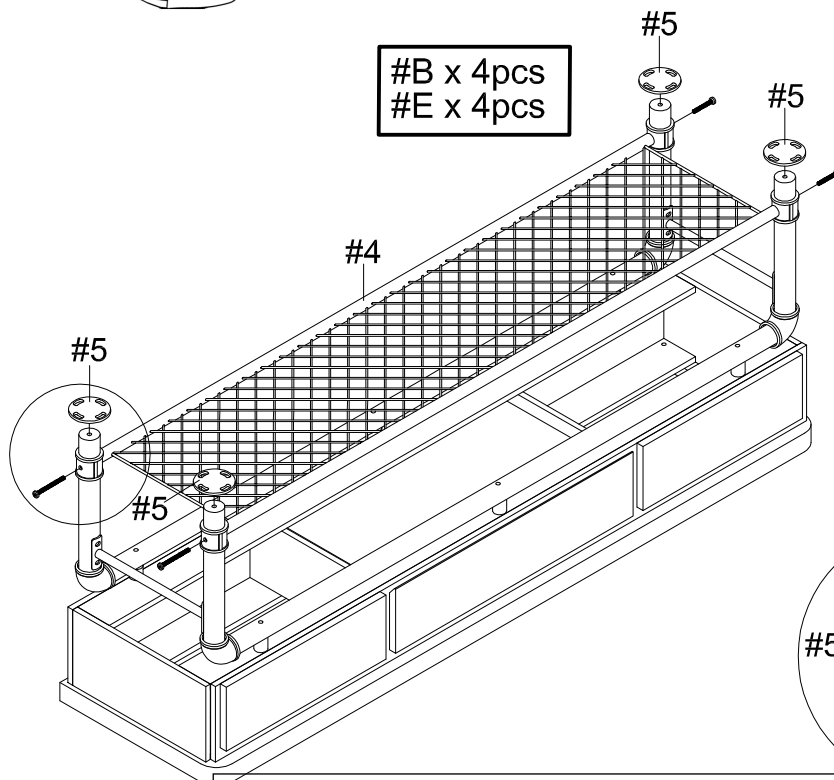
1. Align a washer (#D) then the support frames (#2), insert a bolt (#B) into each and secure.



2. Align the connect tubes (#3) to the holes along the frames, then insert the bolts (#A) and secure.



1. Align the shelf (#4) to the to the holes along the frame ends. Insert a bolt (#B) and secure.



2. Insert the adjustable foots (#5), turn right to tighten. Then place a floor protector (#E) onto each.
